## 4.0 Small Grants Panel 2012/13

Bury Council has an annual allocation of £84,100 for the Small Grant's Fund. The current funding priority is to encourage and support grass-root community activity. ## 5.0 Community First

The fund, **Community First** aims to help groups improve their area and is intended to maximize community involvement in the process whilst expecting neighbourhood groups to match funds with either money or time.

The two eligible wards have set up Panels whose principal role is to identify local priorities for funding and make recommendations relating to projects to be supported. B3SDA is the panel partner. The first Panel meeting was held on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June when the following applications were approved. The Panel will meet 17<sup>th</sup> January 2013 to agree a **Community First plan**, allocate unspent funding for 2012/13 and to assess how the approved Community First funded projects are progressing.
