1.0 Introduction

The Council has allocated £1,000 per ward to support the work of voluntary and community groups. The application funding decisions will be made by the relevant ward councillors. Individual grants to the "ward" fund are available for a maximum of £250. Additionally, a borough-wide allocation of £13,000 is available for "cross-ward" applications from third sector organisations, with a maximum individual grant of £750.

4.0 Small Grants Panel 2012/13

Bury Council has an annual allocation of £84,100 for the Small Grant's Fund. The current funding priority is to encourage and support grass-root community activity. This means small, community-based and locally controlled groups that manage themselves, encourage active participation from volunteers, and have minimal cash reserves and limited access to funding support.

The next meeting of the Small Grants Panel will be 22nd January 2013. The closing date for this round of funding has now closed. From April 2013 Small Grants Funding will be administered by the Council. Community First

The fund, **Community First** aims to help groups improve their area and is intended to maximize community involvement in the process whilst expecting neighbourhood groups to match funds with either money or time.

The two eligible wards have set up Panels whose principal role is to identify local priorities for funding and make recommendations relating to projects to be supported. B3SDA is the panel partner. The first Panel meeting was held on Wednesday 27th June when the following applications were approved. The Panel will meet 17th January 2013 to agree a **Community First plan**, allocate unspent funding for 2012/13 and to assess how the approved Community First funded projects are progressing.
