1	Neville McWilliams	In respect to Openshaw Park Veterans' Bowling Club, Neville explained to the Forum that since the last meeting, he had met with Neil Long regarding the future upgrading of the pavilion but no date, as yet, had been confirmed for any work to begin.	TF Coordinator	Spoken with Neil Long who advised the following: The scheme involves converting the existing open caged area into a conservatory type building. Unfortunately at this time we would not be able to fund it. I have met the club to discuss. Should the club be prepared to take the lead role and do most of the work in developing a funding bid possibly to Biffa or 'Awards for All' then the parks service would provide advice and support with the bid.
2	Resident	Requested an update regarding the replacement of road markings on Bell Lane and Walmersely Road.	Highways	Awaiting feedback from Highways and will update at the Township Forum on Thursday 7 th February.
3	Resident	Raised the issue of the road where Fairfield Drive meets Broad Oak Lane. People are driving far too fast and irresponsibly and it was now a major cause for concern. Acting Inspector, Grant Adams, stated that he would investigate the issue.	Inspector Grant Adams	PCSO Andy Bigland has looked into this problem. He has had regular contact with residents and a local home watch coordinator. He has also conducted high visibility patrols at the location and has not witnessed any speeding issues. This is not to say that it does not occur and he will continue to monitor the situation. Should he witness any speeding then positive action will be taken and he will ensure that he continues to link in with the residents.
