What is the Core Strategy?

The Core Strategy:

- Is a document containing various policies that will be used as the basis for making decisions on future planning applications;
- Sets out how much development the Borough needs to accommodate to 2029;
- Identifies broad locations where this development will be focused;
- Identifies areas of the Borough where built development will be restrained;
- Includes a series of Development Management policies which will include criteria for assessing specific development proposals e.g. setting out what will be required in the design and layout of new development; and
- Includes Township Frameworks which draw out the main areas of the Core Strategy as they affect each Township – leaflets available.



Bury West: Some Key Issues and Aims

KEY CENTRES:

• Support and enhance Bury Key Centre to serve the needs of the Bury West community.

EMPLOYMENT:

 Limited opportunities for significant employment growth within Bury West but to encourage new high quality, office-based employment opportunities in and around Bury town centre, such as at Chamberhall and Townside – areas accessible to Bury West Area.

HOUSING:

• Accommodate around 10% of the Borough's housing target largely as part of mixed use schemes on the edge of Bury town centre.

RETAIL:


• Strengthen the retail role Bury town centre and consolidate local and neighbourhood centres.

FLOOD RISK:

 Manage flood risk – particularly that associated with the River Irwell to the west of Bury town centre (Chamberhall and Western Waterside) and Kirklees Brook.
