SUMMARY:	<p>Bury Council currently has 9 live residents parking schemes across the Borough. The first scheme was introduced in 1998 and was implemented to prevent town centre workers and shoppers parking in nearby residential streets.</p> <p>In order to provide a transparent framework we have developed a Policy that sets out the process we will follow in relation to the introduction of residents parking requests.</p>

- 1.2 In 1983 Greater Manchester Council produced a "Code of Practice" for the assessment of "Residential Privileged On-Street Parking Schemes". In 1999 Greater Manchester Transportation Unit produced a document headed "The Assessment, Prioritisation and Operation of Residents Parking Schemes in Manchester.
- 1.3 This utilised relevant parts of the information contained within Greater Manchester Council's Code of Practice to build a policy, that Bury, has used as guidance over the years to implement Residents Parking Schemes.
- 1.4 In order to provide a transparent framework we have built upon this further and developed a Policy that sets out the process we will follow in relation to the introduction of residents parking requests.

2.0 ISSUES

An ECIA has been completed and no adverse implications have been identified.

3.0 CONCLUSION

The introduction of this policy will allow us to provide a transparent framework which we can use to assess all future requests.
