CHAIR OF AUDIT

Main Role

To undertake the role and responsibility of a Councillor and functions as Chair of the Audit Committee, in accordance with its Terms of Reference;

To take responsibility for and to lead on the Audit Committee function of the Council and to Chair the Audit Committee. To develop a clear understanding of the Terms of Reference of the Committee, the scope and range of the Audit Control function.

Key Accountabilities

In addition to carrying out the functions set out in the Member Role Profile for all Elected Members;

- 1 To lead the work of the Audit Committee.
- 2 To Chair the committee, including;
 - a. working with Officers to determine an Annual (Risk Based)
 Audit Plan, to receive reports from the Head of Internal
 Audit, and to report to the Council where necessary; and
 - b. Representing the Audit Committee functions within and outside the Council, as necessary, to enable it to deliver its objectives within budget and in a cost effective way.
- 3 To attend all Audit Committee meetings.
- To ensure the independence of the Audit Committee; in line with CIPFA professional guidance
- To oversee the Council's Governance arrangements, and monitor compliance with the Council's "Local Code of Corporate Governance".
- To provide strong, fair leadership and clear political guidance to Members and Officers.
- 7 To ensure the overall co-ordination and management of the Committee functions relating to the Terms of Reference of the Committee

- 8 To ensure the efficient carrying out of the process for which the Committee has responsibility.
- 9 To demonstrate fair and open decision-making by or on behalf of the Committee.
- To ensure Members' information needs are met so that they can contribute fully to the decision-making within the process.
- 11 To ensure Committee Members obtain the necessary skills to contribute to the work of the Committee, and to work with Officers to provide training if necessary.
- To be willing to learn about the professional disciplines and services relevant to the work of the Committee.
