Dementia

This Chamber notes that nationally:

- There are currently 820,000 sufferers of Dementia in England and Wales;
- That Dementia is the fastest growing illness for over 65's with 163,000 new cases in England and Wales each year;
- 1 in 3 people over 65 will die with a form of dementia;
- As many as half of dementia sufferers are unaware they have the condition;
- The financial cost of dementia to the UK will be over £23 billion in 2012;
- There are 670,000 carers of people with dementia in the UK

This Chamber notes that in Bury:-

- In 2011 there were 2074 sufferers of dementia in the Borough;
- Over the next 20 years this figure is likely to increase by 50%.

This Council resolves:-

- That the issue of accurate diagnosis, care and support for sufferers of dementia and their families is not a party political issue.
- That Bury will aspire to become the first "Dementia Friendly" Borough in Greater Manchester in line with the "Prime Minister's Challenge of Dementia" promoting:-
 - Awareness of the condition and dispelling the myth that it is the inevitable consequence of aging
 - Working with the Bury CCG and Health and Wellbeing Board to increase the rate of people screened and diagnosed with a form of dementia

 Supporting dementia sufferers and their carers by creating a Dementia Action Alliance comprised of public, voluntary and independent sector partners with a view to training 50 members of the community to become "Dementia Friends" in Bury.
