P.884 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

43584 Land at Deardens Street and Proctor Street, Bury – Church Ward Reserved Matters – Residential Development, 19 Town Houses

42722 Olives Paper Mill, Tottington Road, Bury – Elton Ward Residential Development 116 units together with provision of open space

43509 Land at Bury Road, Sunnywood Lane, Tottington – Tottington Ward Residential Development 24 dwellings

The decision is subject to the following additional condition:-

Condition 14. No gates shall be erected on the access to the development. Reason: - To prevent the establishment of a closed community and to protect the character of the area.

- 3. That application **43783 Land adjacent to 2 Cromer Road, Bury Elton Ward** change of use of land to garden be refused for the following reasons:-
 - 1. The proposed development would, by reason of its size and location, create an intrusive feature at a prominent position in the street scene and would therefore, be seriously detrimental to the visual amenities of the area. The proposed development therefore conflicts with the following policy of the Bury Unitary Development Plan: H2/3 Extensions and Alterations
 - 2. The proposed development, if approved, would result in the loss of valuable amenity open space which would be seriously detrimental to the amenities of nearby residents and the area in general. The proposed development therefore conflicts with the following policies of the Bury Unitary Development Plan:- OL3 Urban Open Space and OL3/1 Protection of Urban Space
- 4. That application 43717 Paddock, off Leaches Road, Shuttleworth Ramsbottom Ramsbottom Ward detached single storey stable block and tack be refused for the following reason:-

The proposed development would, by reason of its height, size, position, building materials and design, be a permanent, prominent and intrusive feature detrimental to the open character and visual amenity of this Green Belt Location. The proposed development therefore conflicts with the following policy of the Bury Unitary Development Plan: - OL1/2 New Buildings in the Green Belt.

P.885 CUSTOMER CHARTER FOR THE PLANNING ENFORCEMENT SERVICE

A report of the Borough Planning and Economic Development Officer was submitted informing the Committee of the results of a consultation exercise on the draft document "Customer Charter for the Planning Enforcement Service" and seeking approval to the publication of the document.
