3.0 End of Grant Form

Elms Community Centre reported the local community are taking more pride in the surrounding areas they live in as a result of the gardening competition. The project has also bought people interested in gardening together to develop the Elms Community Garden, and offer advice and support to anyone wishing to improve the appearance of their own garden.

Hunter's Hill TRA –provided winter warmer packs to 31 elderly / vulnerable people. The packs included blankets, cupboard staples, hand warmers and information leaflets about keeping warm. Local children delivered the packs meeting the elderly residents helping intergenerational relationships. The children were given a selection box for delivering the packs. This project helped everyone realise the TRA include people of all ages in their remit. 20 Children and 31 elderly residents directly benefited from this project.

5.0 Small Grants Panel 2011/12

Bury Council has an annual allocation of £87,000 for the Small Grant's Fund. The current funding priority is to encourage and support grass-root community activity. This means small, community-based and locally controlled groups that manage themselves, encourage active participation from volunteers, and have minimal cash reserves and limited access to funding support.
