Potentially the best option if there are health and safety hazards being created by slippery walkways, would be to remove the footpath's - however doing this will almost definitely raise further complaints  With the natural amount of surface water and rainfall in the last 12 months this issue is becoming more apparent than normal here and at a lot of other sites.
