TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER 2017**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury intend in not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicles from proceeding along:-

Back Hornby Street East, Bury – between Birch Street and Back Argyle Street  
Back Walmersley Road West, Bury – between Birch Street and Monmouth Avenue

The reason for the proposed order is to enable telecommunications/broadband works to be carried out.

The alternative route will be via adjacent local streets and will be signed on site.

The proposed Order will come into operation on Thursday 11 May 2017 and shall remain in force for a period of up to 2 months, although the anticipated duration of the works is approximately 3 weeks.
