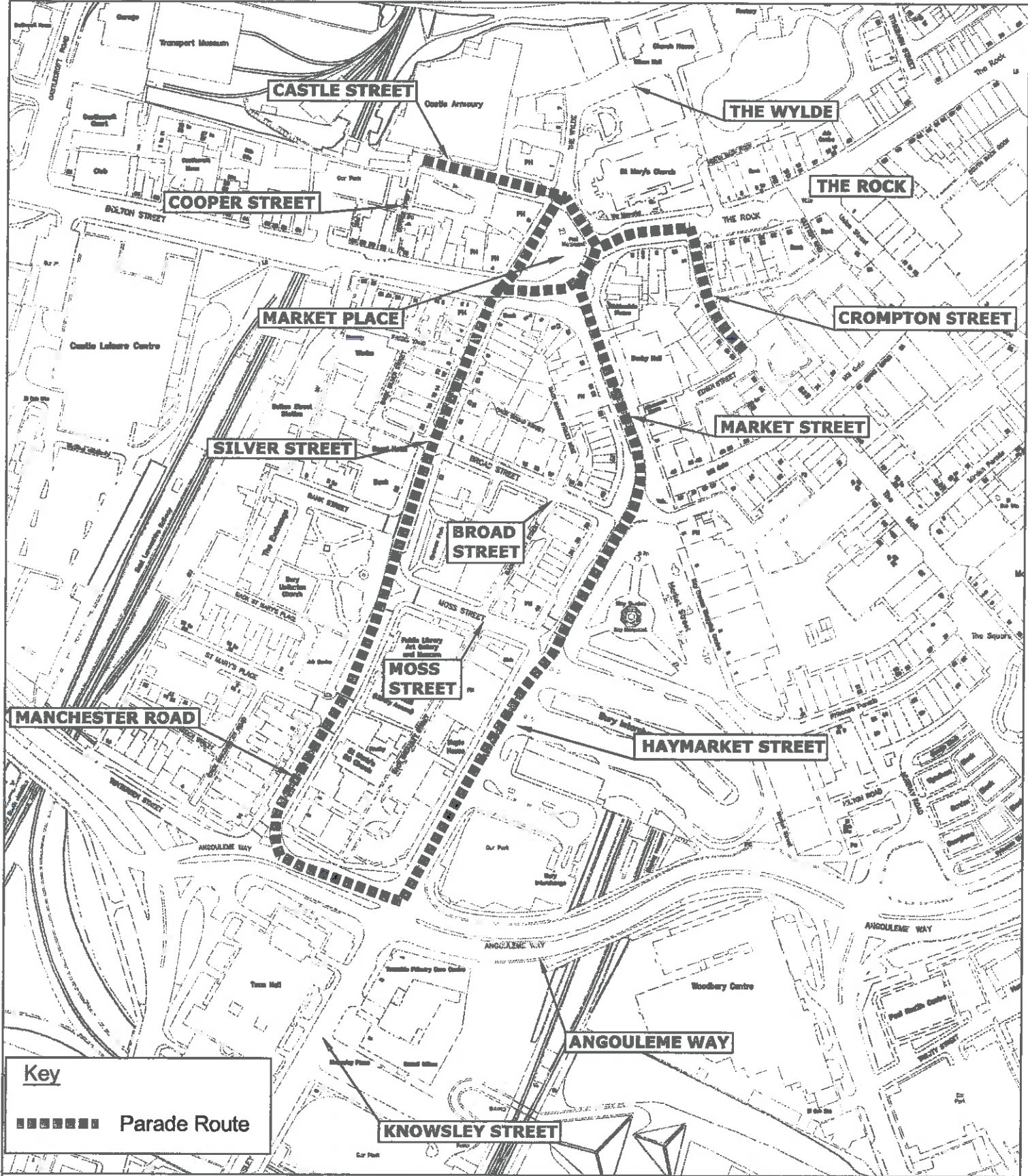

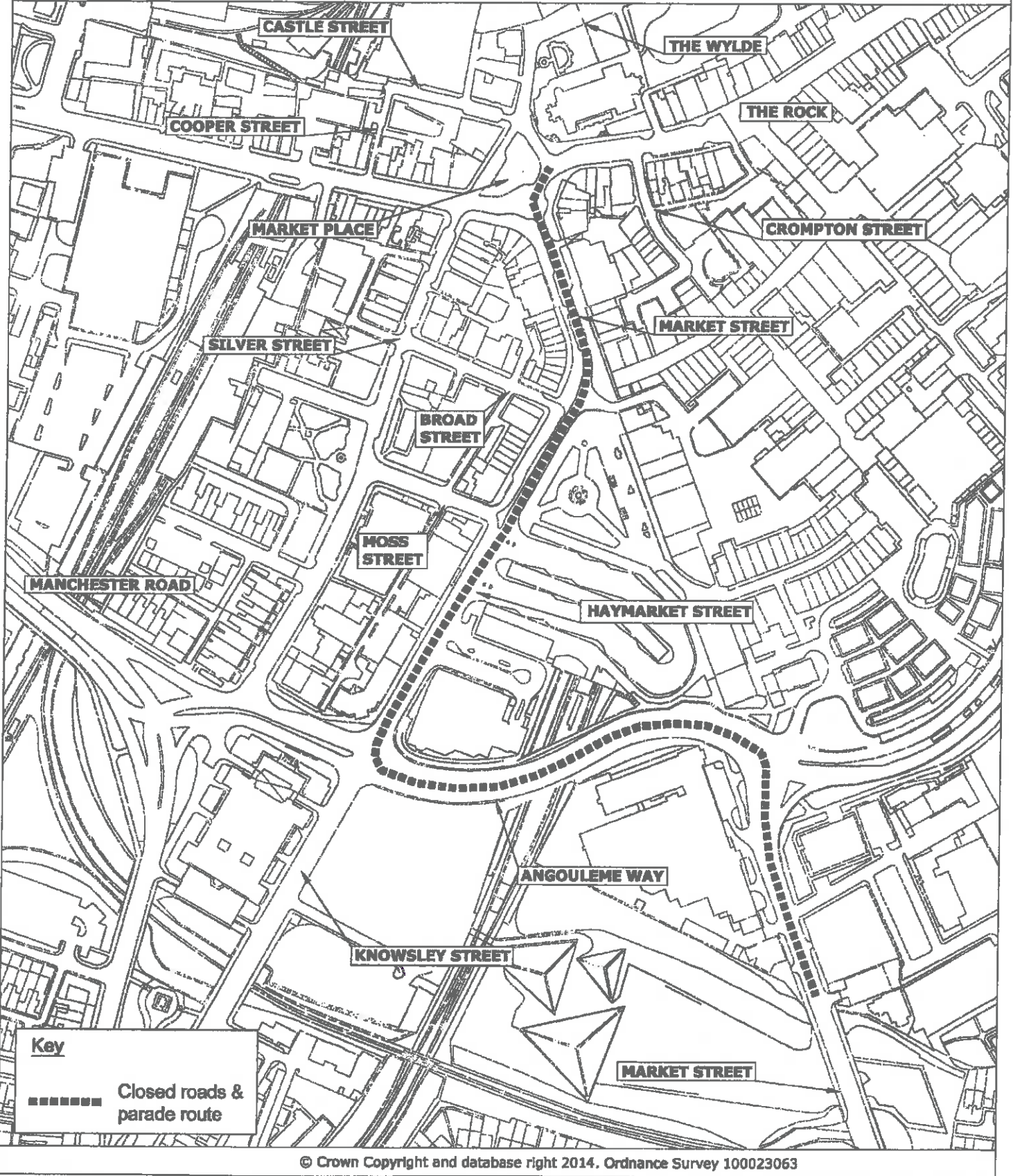

ASSOCIATION ST GEORGE'S DAY PARADE)  
TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 2017**

I refer to your correspondence of 18 April 2017.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby agrees, by authority of section 16B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), that an Order relating to a temporary traffic restriction, when made by your Council under section 16A of the Act, can continue in force from 23 April 2017 in order to facilitate the Gallipoli Parade and the Scout Association St George's Day Parade.

The highways to be restricted/closed to traffic are all as stated in the draft Order.

You are reminded that the published Order cannot, at any time, prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road.
