

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14A(2)(VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTWICH - HEATON PARK EVENTS) TEMPORARY CLOSURE, TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING, TEMPORARY CLEARWAY AND TEMPORARY HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND NOTICE 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That under the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the following restrictions shall apply:-

1) (1) In this Notice:

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Management Act 2004 and "resident permit" means a permit issued by Heaton Park Management of Manchester City Council on behalf of the Council for Heaton Park Events (Parklife) 10 June to 12 June 2017.

(2) For the purposes of Article 8 of this Notice a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

a resident permit in the relevant position, when:-

- (i) In the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the permit is exhibited thereon so that the permit is legible from the outside of the vehicle; or
- (ii) In the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the permit is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the permit is legible from the outside of the vehicle

(3) (i)

Any reference to a Post Office vehicle shall be deemed to be a reference to a vehicle of a universal service provider

- (ii) Any reference to a vehicle bearing Royal Mail livery shall be deemed to include a reference to a vehicle bearing livery which is used by a universal service provider

- (iii) Any reference to the carrying out of a statutory duty of the Post Office shall be deemed to be a reference to the provision of a universal postal service

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Notice as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

- 2) until the said event is completed no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicles to proceed along Scholes Lane, Meade Hill Road and Whittaker Lane between the hours of 09.00 and 01.00 (approximately) 10/11/12 June 2017 along the length(s) of street(s) as specified in Schedule 1 below
- 3) until the said event is completed no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicles to proceed along the length(s) of street(s) as specified in Schedule 2, between the hours of 09.00 and 01.00 (approximately), Schedule 3 and Schedule 4 between the hours of 20.00 and 0100 10/11/12 June 2017 below
- 4) until the said event is completed no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicles to wait, load and unload between the hours of 09.00 and 01.00 (approximately) 10/11/12 June 2017 along the length(s) of street(s) as specified in Schedule 3 and in Schedule 4 below
- 5) until the said event is completed no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicles to wait, load, unload and stop between the hours of 09.00 and 01.00 (approximately) 10/11/12 June 2017 along the length(s) of street(s) as specified in Schedule 5 and Schedule 7 below
- 6) until the said event is completed no person shall except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicles, except Hackney Carriages to wait, load and unload between the hours of 09.00 and 01.00 (approximately) 10/11/12 June 2017 along the length(s) of street(s) as specified in Schedule 6 below
- 7) the Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- 8) the reason for the proposed Notice is in order to assist traffic management movement and maintain public safety in connection with the Parklife Event in Heaton Park.
- 9) Nothing in Article 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Notice shall apply to emergency vehicles, buses and any vehicle engaged in the

operation of the event and in the implementation, removal or enforcement of the restrictions introduced pursuant to this Order.

- 10) Nothing in Article 4 and 6 of this Notice shall apply to any vehicle displaying a valid resident permit
- 11) Nothing in Article 3 of this Notice shall apply to private hire vehicles and other motor vehicles entering and leaving the event private hire and parking facilities
- 12) Nothing in Article 4 and 5 of this Notice shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in that Article so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any funeral, building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length(s) of road referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length(s) of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications act 1984;
 - (c) the vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle if it is in the service or employed by the Post office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post office Act 1953; or
 - (e) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length(s) of road
 - (f) fire brigade, ambulance or police operations to be carried out.

This Notice shall come into operation on 10 June 2017 and will remain in force from Saturday 10 June 2017 and shall have effect for a maximum of 5 days or until completion of the events, whichever is the sooner.

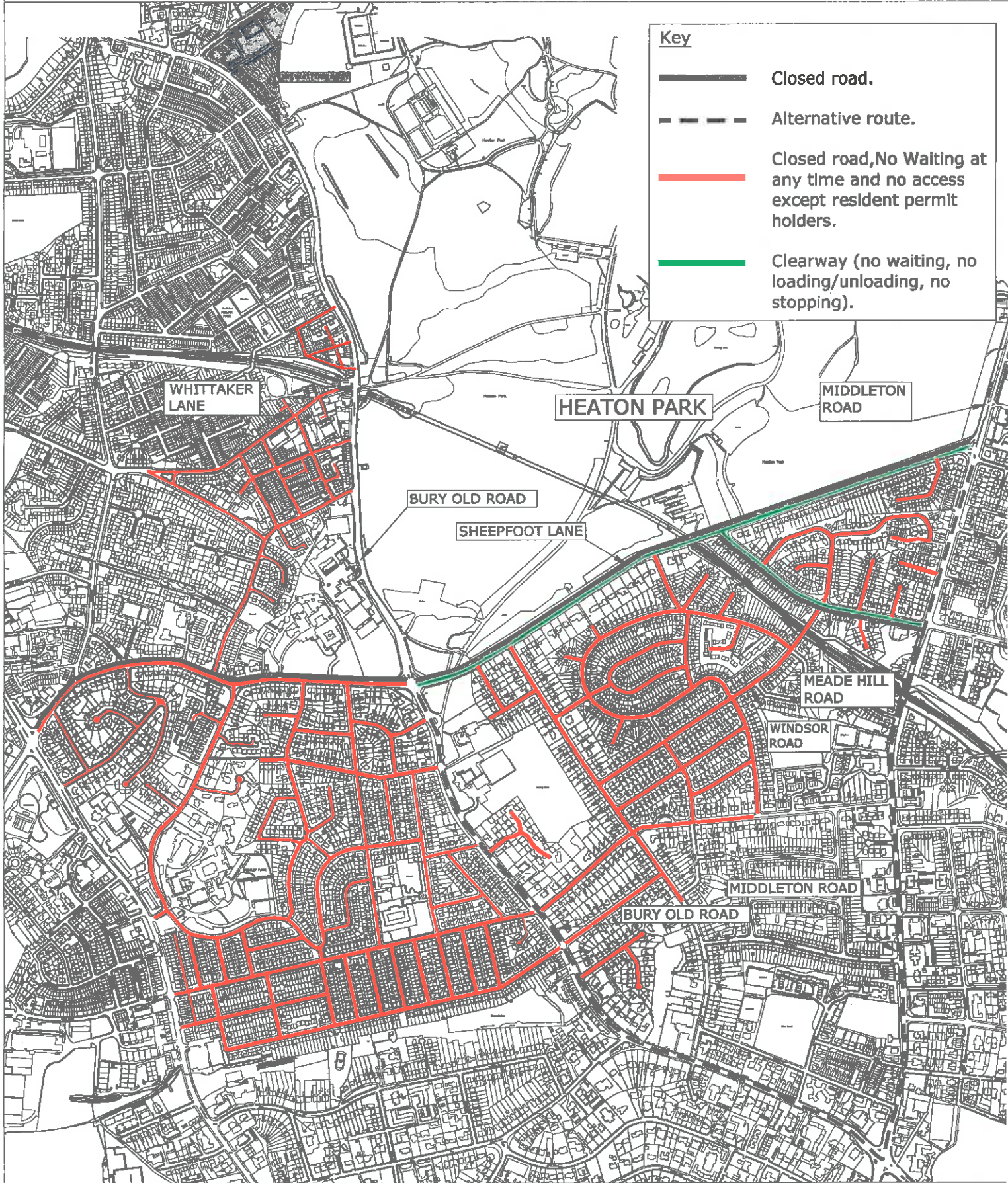

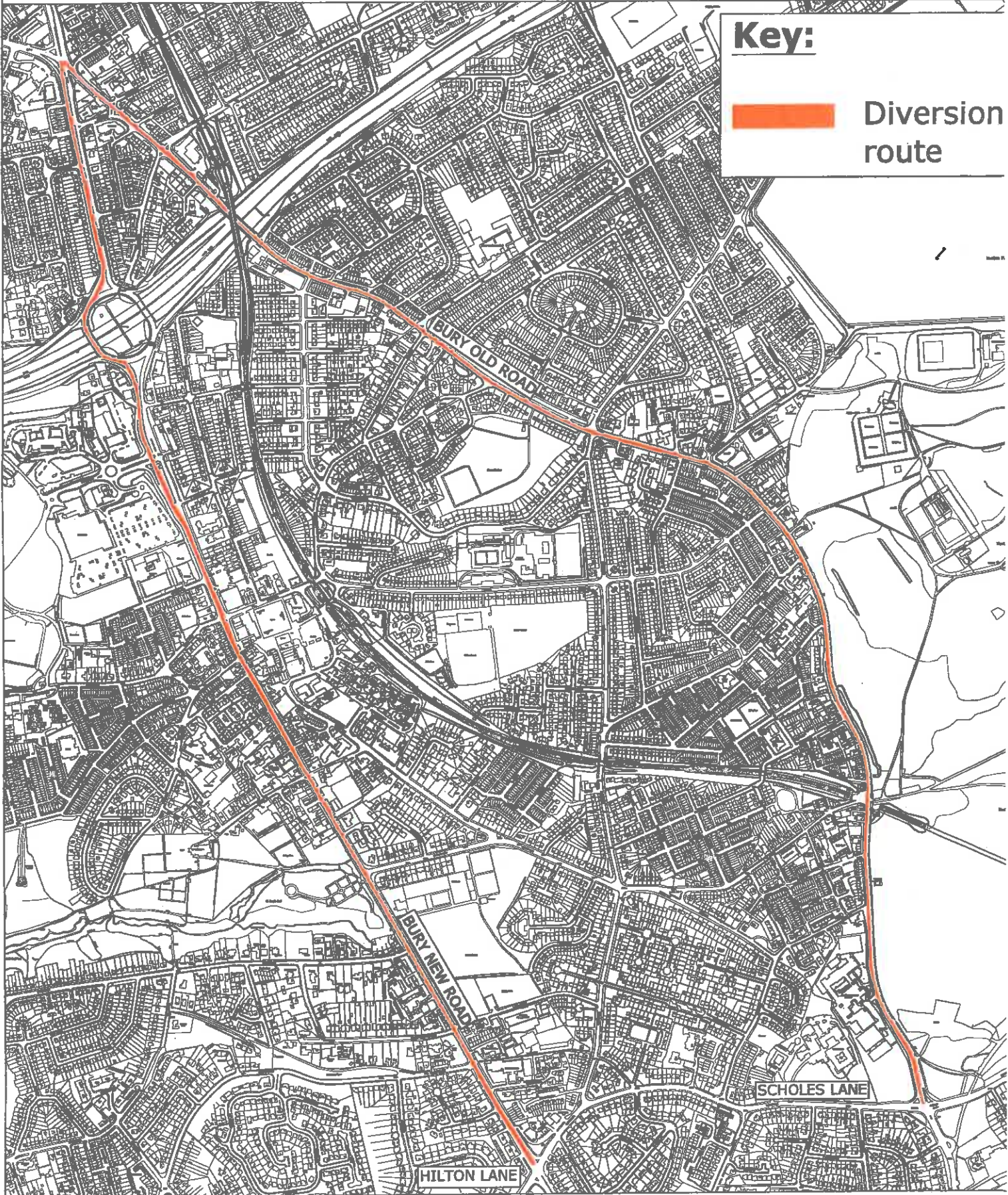
Prestwich Diversion route

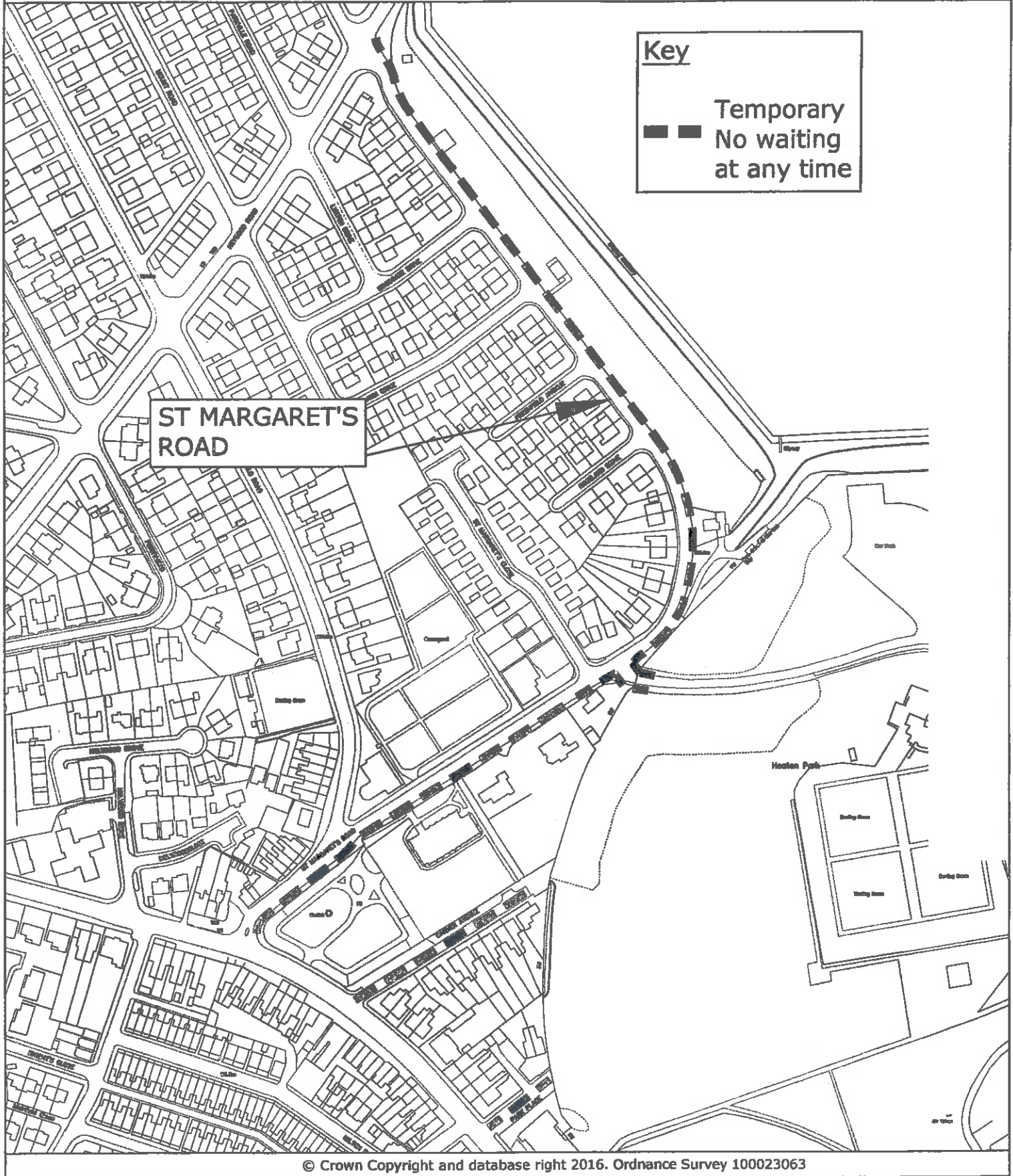

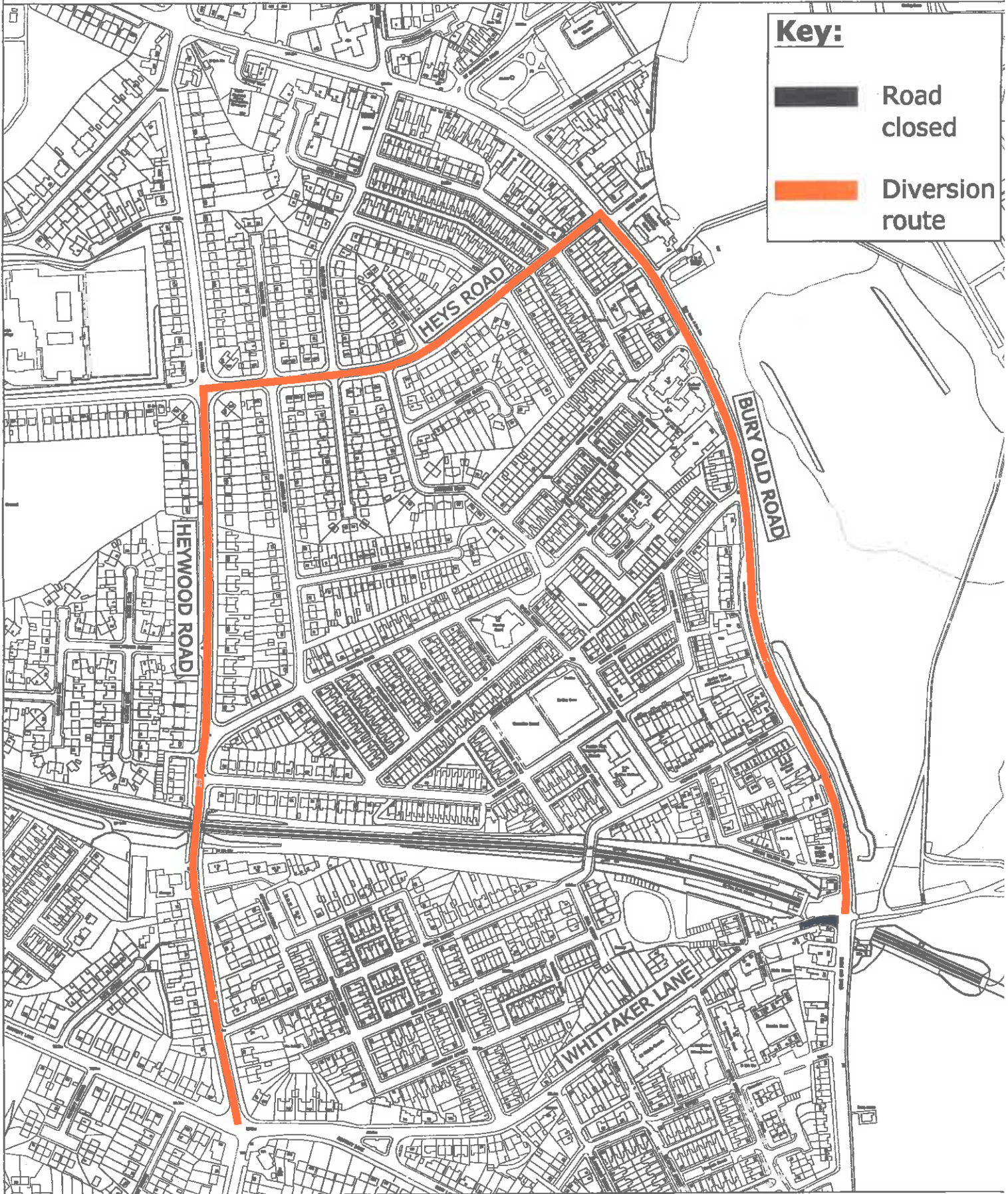

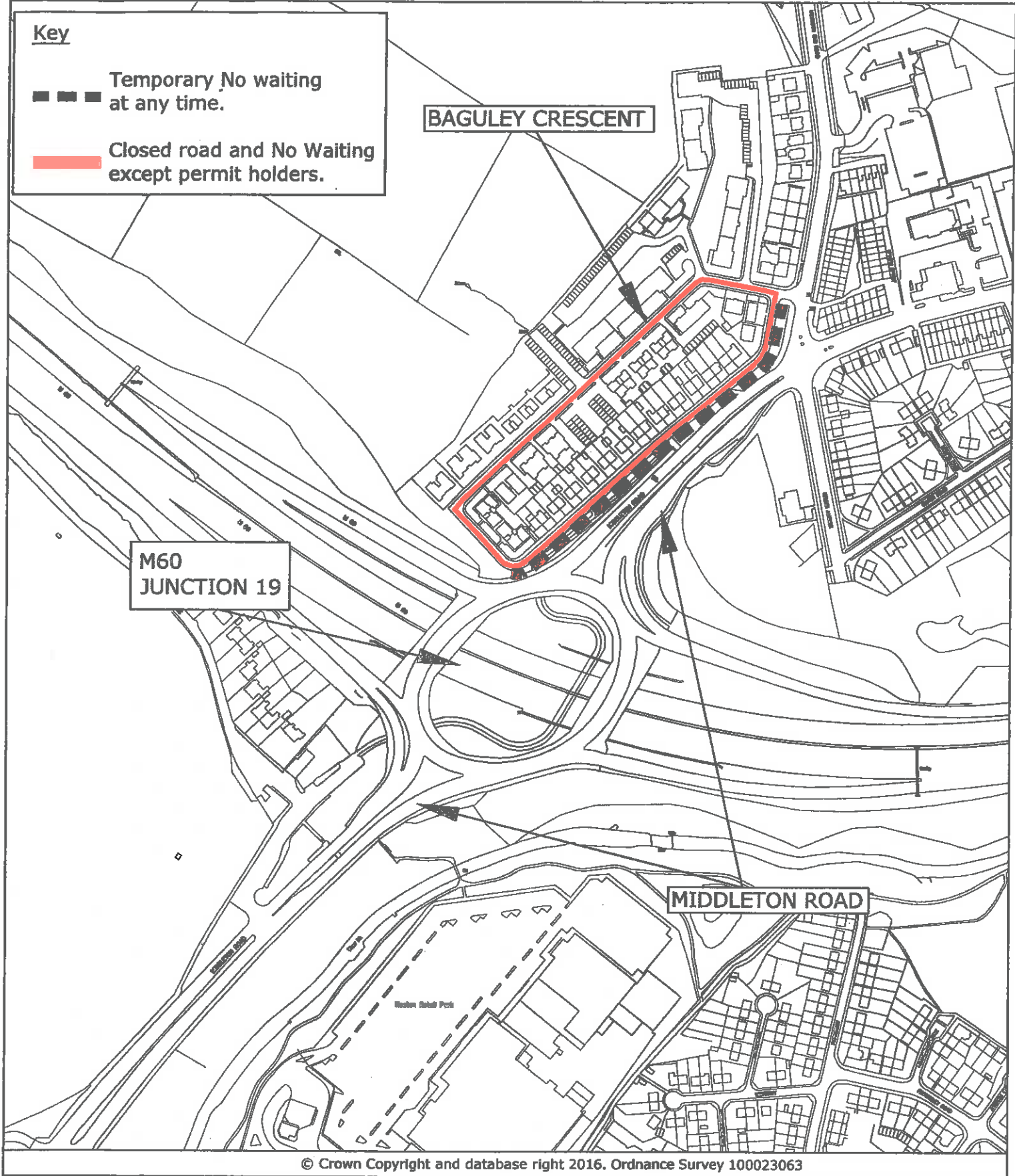


Sheepfoot Lane Area, Prestwich Temporary Waiting Restrictions
