## STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

## TM2/17/411:- CAMERON STREET, BURY

A request has been received from Cameron House Nursing Home, which is situated on Cameron Street, Bury for the introduction of some restrictions to assist ambulances attending their premises.

Given the nature of the premises there is regular attendance by emergency ambulance and also patient transport, which access the building via the small dropped kerb and ramp to the main entrance. Due to parking which occurs on both sides of Cameron Street ambulances are sometimes forced to park in the middle of the road potentially blocking traffic.

Cameron Street is 6.6 metres wide, vehicles park fully on the road on the west side of Cameron Street with vehicles parking partly on the footway. This leaves around 3.2 metres for traffic.

Information from the ambulance service has indicated that their largest vehicle is 2.7 metres wide and 10.3 metres long with the rear ramp fully extended.

As such a bay of 2.7 metres would be required to accommodate an ambulance.

This would leave 2.4 metres for traffic, assuming vehicles continue to park fully on the road on the opposite side, however there will be significant periods when the bay is not occupied. Site observations have shown that generally there are spaces available to accommodate the small amount of parking that is likely to occur as a result of the proposal.

This was discussed by the Traffic Management Unit at its meeting of 09 June 2017, the decision being to recommend the introduction of No Stopping at Any time Except Ambulances restriction on Cameron Street, Bury to assist ambulance service vehicle access to Cameron House.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.


