STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

TM2/17/410:- UN-NAMED ACCESS ROAD LINKING RINGLEY ROAD AND OLD HALL LANE (REDCOT COURT), WHITEFIELD

Ongoing concerns have been raised with the Council regarding access to the residential properties on Redcot Court.

The Un-named Access Road leading to Redcot Court does not form part of the adopted highway.

Discussions with the Fire Service have confirmed that parking on the Un-named Access Road Linking Ringley Road and Old Hall Lane could potentially hinder access to Redcot Court. Whilst this would be the Fire Service preferred access to Redcot Court there are alternative possibilities of access should it be required in an emergency. The Refuse Collection Service also access Redcot Court from Ringley Road and then the Un-named Access Road.

Given that the parking appears to be residential, the Council have highlighted issues to residents of Old Hall Court, Redcot Court and what is believed to be the owner of Old Hall Court in the form of a letter. Despite this, parking continues on the Un-named Access Road.

This was discussed by the Traffic Management Unit at its meeting of 09 June 2017, the decision being to recommend the introduction of No Waiting at Any time restrictions on the Un-named Access Road Linking Ringley Road and Old Hall Lane (Redcot Court), Whitefield to alleviate access/egress problems, particularly for larger vehicles.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.


