Hunstanton Drive, Bury – northerly side from a point 12 metres west of the westerly kerbline of Woodhill Road to Brandlesholme Road

Hunstanton Drive, Bury – southerly side from Brandlesholme Road to a point 20 metres east of Brandlesholme Road

Brandlesholme Road, Bury – easterly side from a point 25 metres south of the southerly kerbline of Hunstanton Drive to a point 25 metres north of the northerly kerbline of Hunstanton Drive

Nothing in this notice will apply to emergency vehicles, and any vehicle engaged in the implementation, removal or enforcement of the restrictions introduced pursuant to this notice.
