

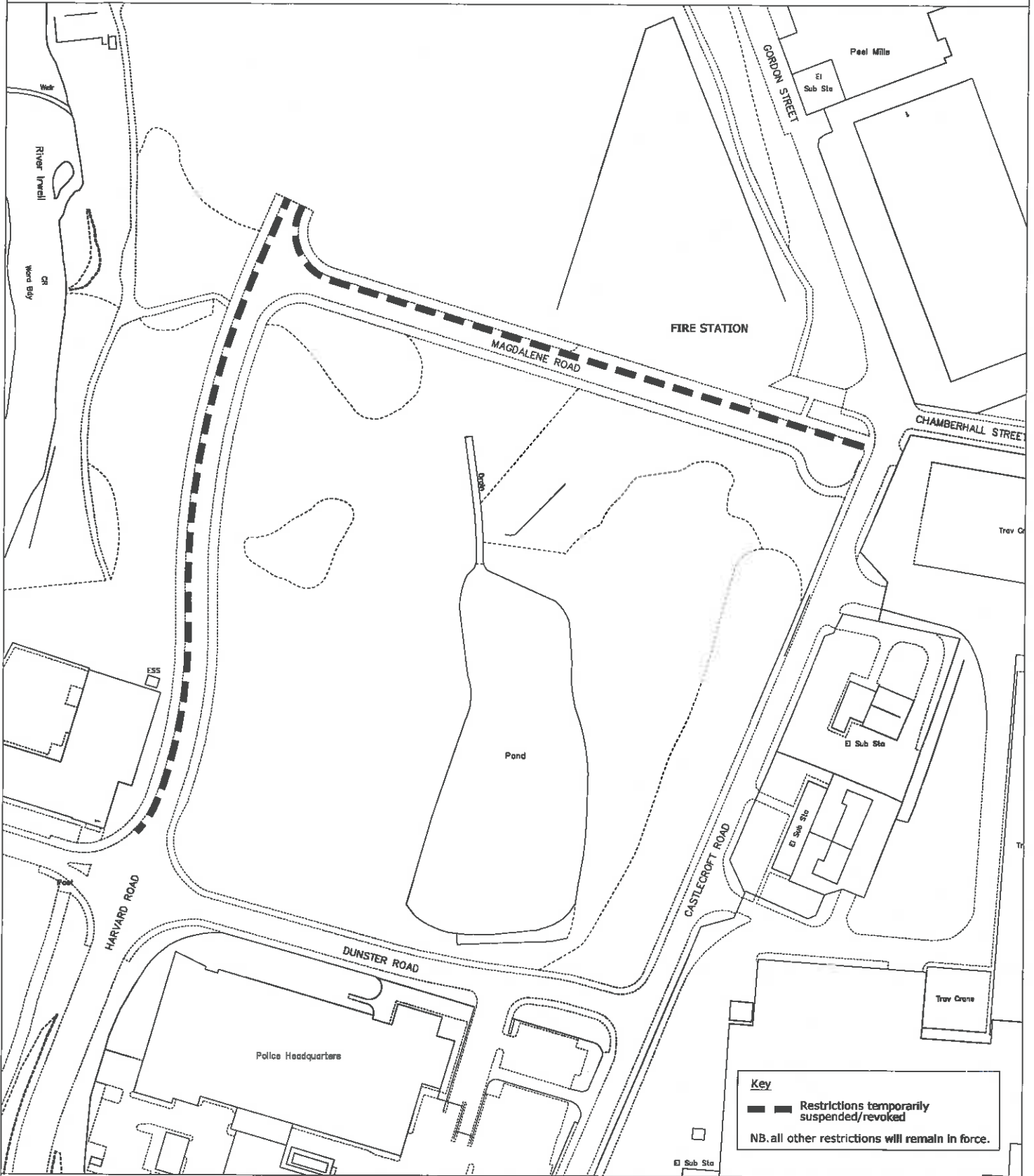
The reason for the proposed order is to facilitate the holding of the Bury Fire Station Open Day.
