






Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Permission is requested to create a Staying Well Service that operates throughout the borough for Older People. Bury’s Staying Well service will be a prevention and early intervention service which aims to improve the health, wellbeing and quality of life of people aged 65 years and above. • Funding has been granted from the Better Care Fund to implement and pilot the project for a 3 year period. • It is proposed to appoint a Team Leader, 6 x Staying Well Co-Coordinator and a Project Support Officer to manage and implement the project. 	

- The proposed new Staying Well Service for Older People aim to achieve the following outcomes:-
 - A reduction in the need for social care support;
 - An improvement in healthy lifestyles;
 - An increased uptake of relevant screening and vaccination programmes;
 - Supporting residents to remain in their own home (where it is safe to do so);
 - A reduction in loneliness and social isolation;
 - An improvement in decent homes standards;
 - Increased access to a range of community provision that can support improvements in health and wellbeing;
 - The proposed new service will have a positive impact on older people;
