The anticipated duration is 18 months, an application to the Secretary of State will be required for an extension of the initial closure. The diversion route is via the remainder of Public Footpath 8, Whitefield, Public Footpath 6, Whitefield, Public Footpath 89, Bury, Restricted Byway 85, Bury, Parr Lane and Public Footpath 101, Bury and vice versa.



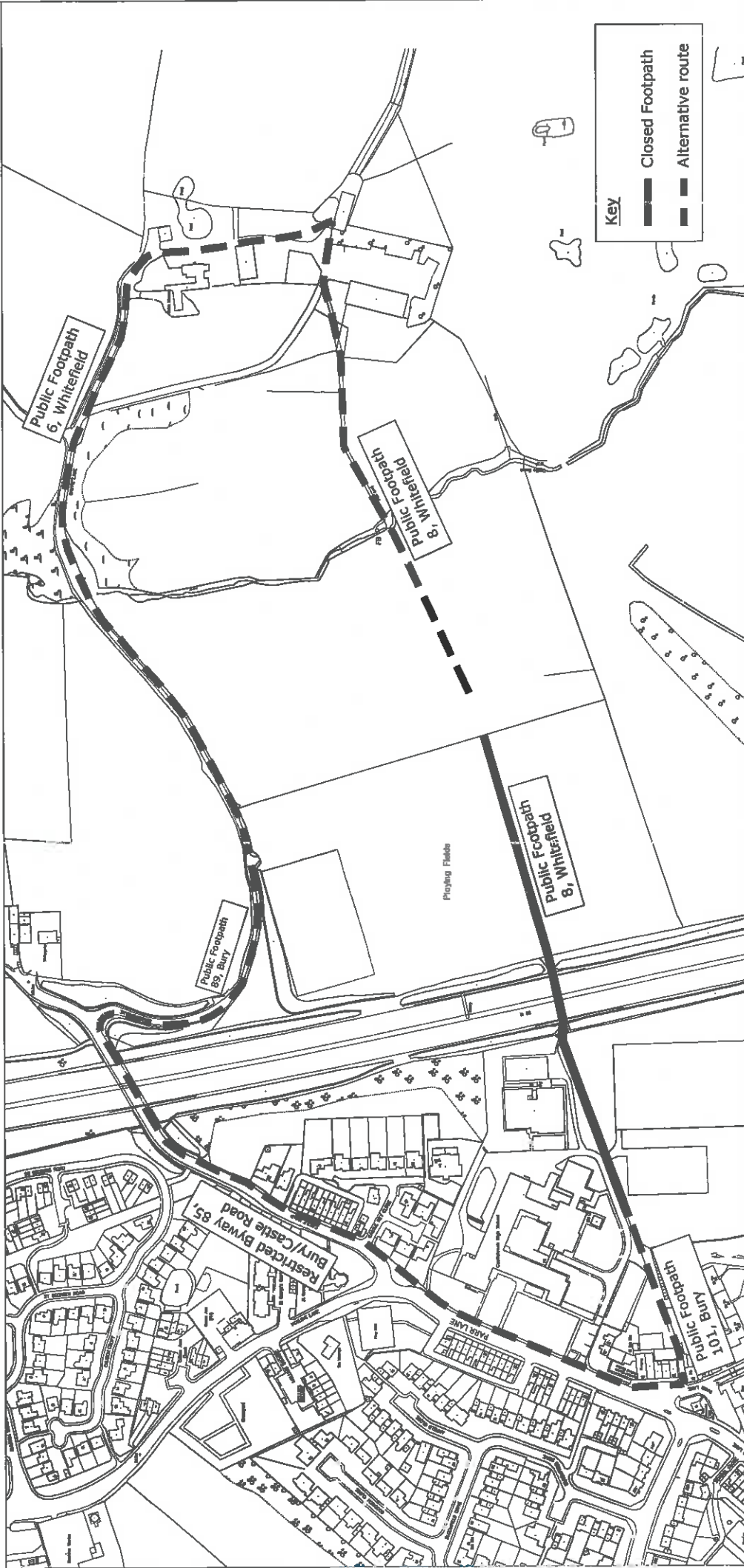
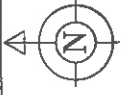
