## STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

## TM2/18/444:- HASLAM BROW, BURY

Concerns have recently been raised regarding parking and speeding traffic on Haslam Brow.

Haslam Brow is a narrow road which realistically only allows traffic to travel in one direction at a time, with a narrow footway only on one side. It provides access to a small number of residential properties and Bury Church of England High School.

The concerns relate to vehicles parking on Haslam Brow, reportedly fully on the footway due to the width of the road itself, and opposite driveways. It is suggested that sometimes it is only one or two parked vehicles, however on occasions when school is hosting events there is the potential for on street parking. Given the width of the road and angle at which driveways connect to Haslam Brow residents report that any vehicles parked opposite can prevent them getting off driveways.

Observations have not revealed parking on Haslam Brow. However, whilst no vehicles have been observed to be parked on Haslam Brow it is apparent the potential problem that such parking could cause.

Whilst access to residential problems could perhaps be managed, given that Haslam Brow is the only access to the school it is thought that the introduction of waiting restrictions to prevent parking would be beneficial in this location.

This was discussed by the Traffic Management Unit at its meeting of 27 November 2018, the decision being to recommend the introduction of No Waiting at Any time restrictions on Haslam Brow, in order to maintain traffic movements and access.


