Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

The proposal is to bring together Highway Maintenance, Street Lighting and Grounds Maintenance Services under the leadership of a new position of Head of Street Scene Maintenance. It is proposed that recruitment for the new position is ring-fenced to the two most senior and qualified positions of Group Engineer Street Lighting and Group Engineer Highway Maintenance. Following the appropriate recruitment process it is proposed to delete the resulting vacant Group Engineer position.

The Grounds Maintenance Manager and Business Development Manager have not be ringfenced for recruitment because they not have the required level of qualification.

The Head of Street Scene Maintenance will be responsible for the longer term street scene maintenance strategies as well as the developing joined up structures and systems and the development of efficient and effective back office structures.

Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

It is also proposed that the Head of Street Scene Maintenance be directly responsible for the existing Business Development Manager currently working alongside the Grounds Maintenance Team.

The proposed restructure has already been through due process including the new position have job evaluation and moderation. The business case has also been to the relevant S188 meeting and 30 day consultation.

The cost of the restructure is £3823 and will be funded from savings already achieved within highway maintenance back office structure. It is expected that the new position will come into effect in January 2019.
