**THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF BURY  
ORDER FOR PREVENTING OBSTRUCTION UNDER TOWN POLICE  
CLAUSES ACT 1847 SECTION 21**

**WHEREAS** it appears to the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury that the undermentioned lengths of streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed on the occasion of Beer Festival Event on Friday 03 May, Saturday 04 May and Sunday 05 May 2019 (between approx. 5pm – 10.30pm Friday and 12 noon and 10.30 pm Sat & Sun)

**NOW THEREFORE** the said Council in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 hereby makes the following Order for the purpose of preventing obstruction in such lengths of streets.

Except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform no person shall proceed along the following length of streets.

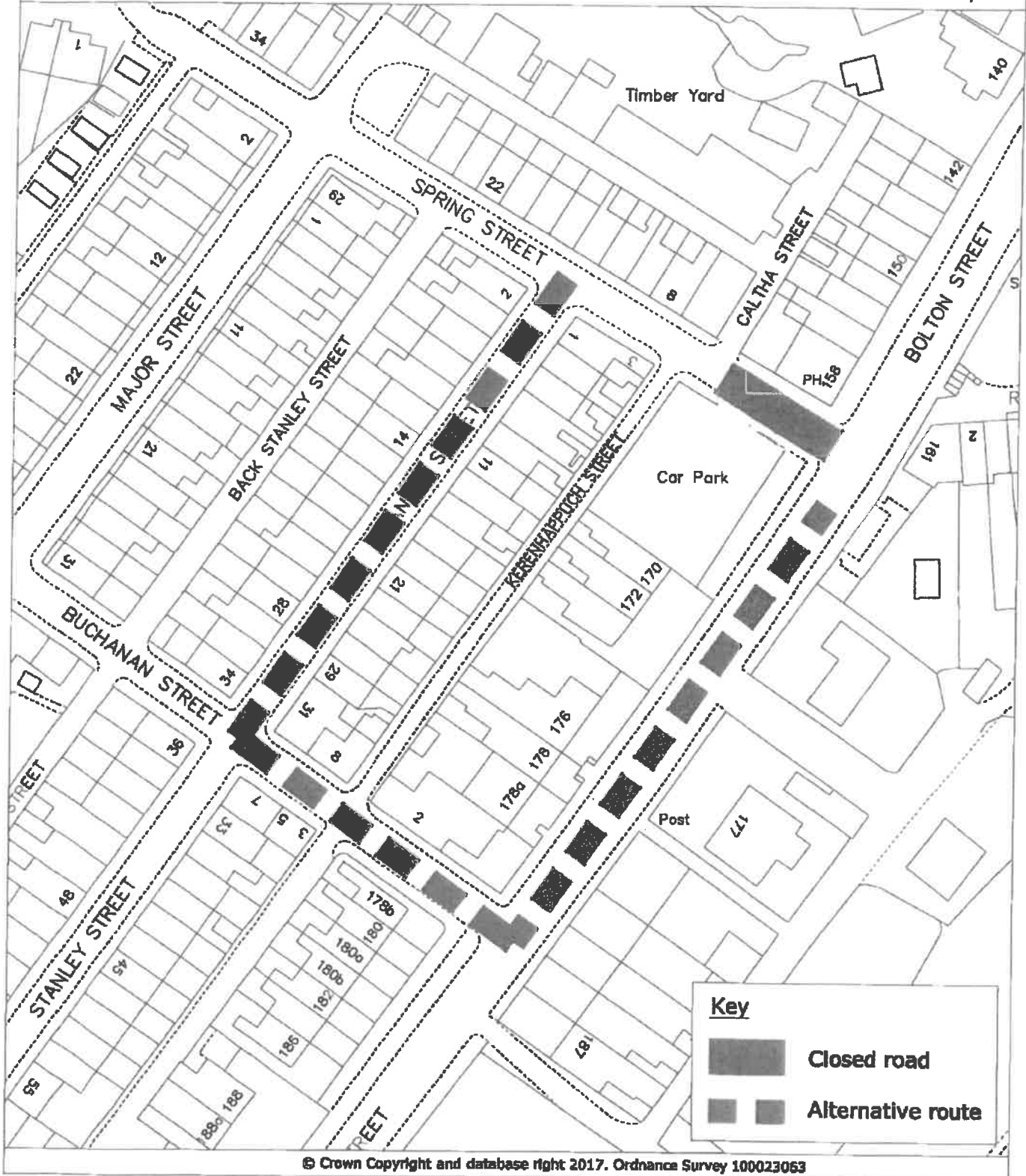
Spring Street, Ramsbottom – between Bolton Street and Caltha Street
