COMMENTS ON THE OBJECTIONS RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO THE ADVERTISEMENT OF THE PROPOSALS

Introduction:

A request has been received for consideration to be given to the removal of some of the limited waiting bay on St Margaret's Road, opposite Polefield Road (limited waiting 30 minutes, no return 30 minutes, Monday to Saturday 8am – 6pm) in order to increase longer term parking for local residents.

Given the closure of several businesses and shops including a bank and post office during the last few years it is considered appropriate to remove some of the limited waiting on St Margaret's Road and increase unrestricted parking for local residents, shops and local businesses.

This was discussed by the Traffic Management Unit at its meeting of 27 November 2018, the decision being to recommend the removal of some of the limited waiting restrictions on St Margaret's Road.

The advertised proposals (Bury Times 28 March 2019 edition) were as follows:-

Revocation of Limited Waiting, Mon-Sat 8am-6pm (30 minutes, no return 30 minutes)

St Margaret's Road, Prestwich

South side, from a point 106.4 metres east of the easterly kerbline of Bury Old Road for a distance of 18 metres in a westerly direction

Objections:

Following the advertisement of the proposals the Council received one objection from a local resident that the length of the removal of the limited waiting restriction should be extended in order to increase the road space in the area to facilitate parking for residents.

Comments on Objections:

The removal of further limited waiting will impact on local businesses where despite some business closures in the area demand for on-street parking near to shops remains high especially during the working week.

In view of the above, it is proposed to introduce the removal of restrictions as advertised and as described in the schedule below.

Revocation of Limited Waiting, Mon-Sat 8am-6pm (30 minutes, no return 30 minutes)

St Margaret's Road, Prestwich South side, from a point 106.4 metres

east of the easterly kerbline of Bury Old Road for a distance of 18 metres in a

westerly direction

Limited Waiting, Mon-Sat 8am-6pm (30 minutes, no return 30 minutes) to remain


St Margaret's Road, Prestwich South side, from a point 15 metres east
