Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

Following the completion of formal consultation with Trade Unions and employees, and the approval of the HR & Appeals Committee, to proceed to establish a new post of Assistant Director (Early Help & School Readiness). The post has been graded as Chief Officer Band D.

The post will lead a newly formed Division, bringing together a set of services from across the existing Education & Inclusion and Social Care portfolios into a cohesive and integrated service.

The remit of the post will include developing and leading:

- Integrated locality based Early Help services, including Children's Centres, prethreshold social care and youth offending services.
- School Readiness and School Attendance Teams
- Youth, youth participation and Connexions services

The key deliverables of the post will be:-

- To develop and deliver effective integrated locality based early help services across the borough.
- To strategically drive and embed the school readiness agenda, ensuring that all Bury children have the best possible start in education.

The role is required to ensure that there is dedicated senior management capacity to develop these crucial areas of work. Successful intervention and support at an early stage will support the management of demand pressures on statutory social services, facilitating the delivery of cost savings over the medium term.

This will be funded from within the Early Years Block of the Dedicated Schools Grant.
