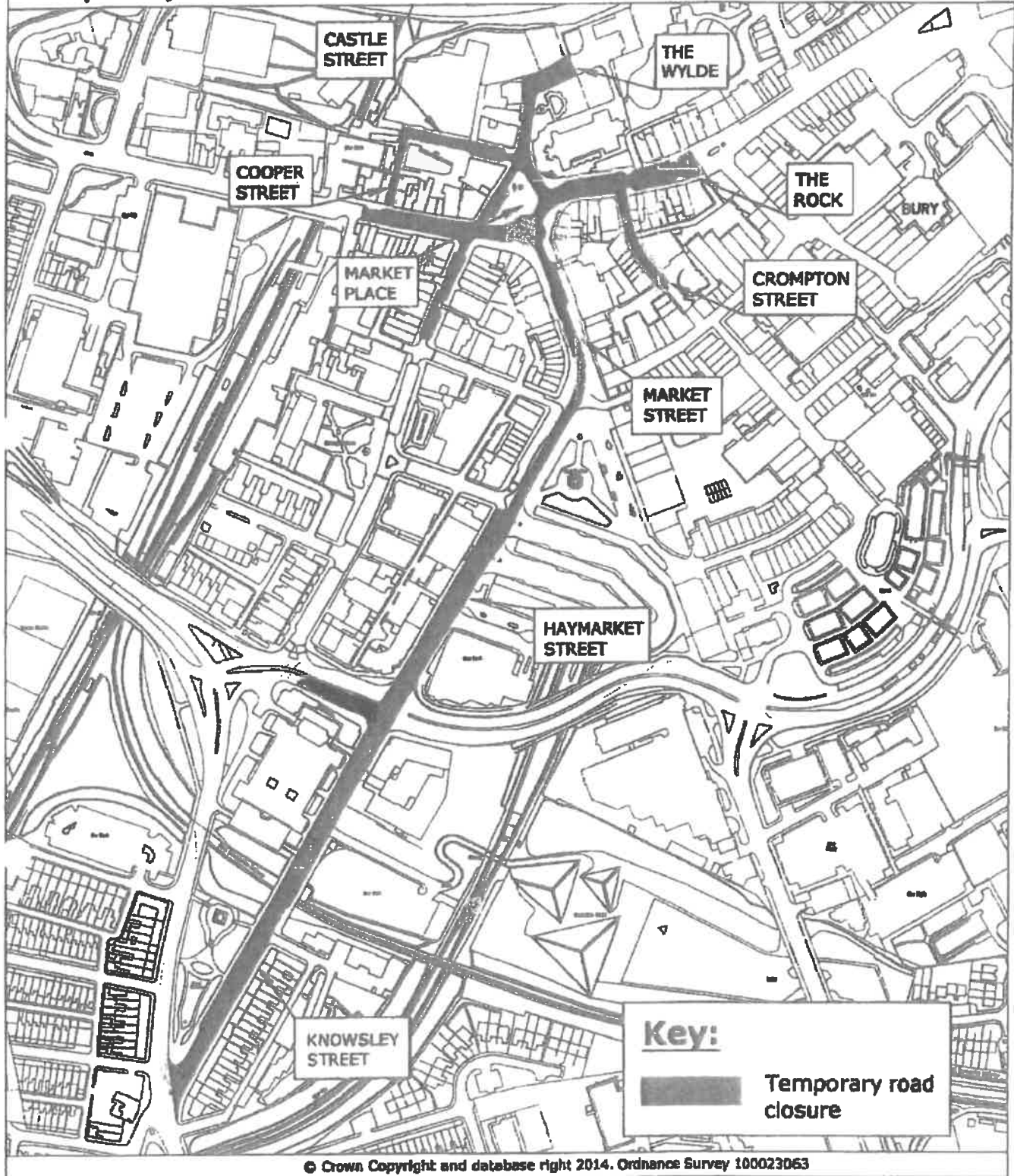

**THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF BURY  
ORDER FOR PREVENTING OBSTRUCTION UNDER TOWN POLICE  
CLAUSES ACT 1847 SECTION 21**

**WHEREAS** it appears to the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury that the undermentioned lengths of streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed on the occasion of the Remembrance Sunday Parade on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019 (10.00-14.00 implemented as required)

**NOW THEREFORE** the said Council in exercise of its powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 Section 21 hereby makes the following Order for the purpose of preventing obstruction in such lengths of streets.

Except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable or a traffic warden in uniform no person shall proceed along the following length of streets as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, between the hours of 10am and 2pm in lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 of this Order on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

The reason for the Order is to permit the holding of the Remembrance Sunday Parade. There is no practicable alternative route.
