Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:			
Upon Academy conversion of the former Castlebrook High School in January 2017, the Council agreed lease arrangements for the land and property on Parr Lane, Unsworth with The Shaw Education Trust.			
The lease agreed between the Council and The Shaw Education Trust anticipated that part of the school site would become excess to the schools requirements upon completion of the new school building constructed through the Priority School Building Programme. Provision was made in the lease for The Shaw Trust to release the surplus land, and for this land to revert to Council control.			
The school took occupation of the new building in August 2019.			
Approval is sought to exercise the clause in the lease agreement and serve notice on The Shaw Trust to surrender the surplus land.
