Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]: The resurfacing of Derby Street Prestwich is an issue that has been going on for some time. The Council own the Road and we are required to resurface it due to its poor condition. The Council has the ability to charge Great Places Housing Association for a fair proportion of the cost of any maintenance. Great Places own the bungalow development on the right hand side and Great Places have agreed to fund 55% of the costs (£8525). The Council contribution will be £6,975 + 1,550 (10% fees) = £8,525. Therefore I require a budget to be able to pay for the resurfacing fees that the council are responsible for. The cost will be a Capitalised against the housing budget for the £8,525 council contribution and Greater Places will be invoiced for the balance.
