Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

In response to the Covid-19 crisis and associated Government guidance the following service changes are to be implemented within Streetscene:

- All play areas, outdoor gyms, ball zones and tennis courts have been shut;
- Highways are only completing repairs to defects that are a danger to road users. Operatives have been temporarily moved to task and finish;
- Street lighting operatives have been stood down and will only respond to emergencies;
- Grounds Maintenance operatives have been partially stood down. Burial and tree
 teams are on standby, litter/dog bins within parks are being emptied and
 perimeter play area inspections will be carried out to ensure they remain closed to
 the public.

All operatives have been informed that they may be asked to support Priority 1 services in the future.
