### **Details of Operational Decision Taken** [with reasons]:

Pest Control Service to be reduced from full service to restricted service to reduce unnecessary and avoidable contact with the public during the COVID-19 pandemic Lockdown.

From date of operation decision ONLY <u>Emergency</u> and <u>Essential</u> Pest control services will be provided to the public/businesses.

<u>Emergency</u> Visit/Revisit - rat running around a property/business would continue to receive an immediate service. As per existing policy and COVID-19 controls.

<u>Essential</u> Visit/Revisit – These will be risk assessed and triaged and only if absolutely necessary will received a service/treatment. Essential jobs defined as

- i) Active, and
- ii) Internal domestic/commercial premises, and
- iii) Pest presents a public health risk to the occupants. (Such as Active rat, mice, insects infestation)

All other pest issues will be classified as Delayable – These job types will be delayed until an appropriate future time after the Lockdown period. These jobs will be reviewed weekly and customers contacted once pest control officers are able to safety visit.
