Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

In the wake of the PM's instructions, all resurfacing schemes being managed by Engineering Services which are currently underway are being seen through to completion. This is because scarified surfaces with raised ironwork (manhole covers and gully grates etc.) are more likely to become safety issues should they be left unattended for prolonged periods. Also, left in such a state, the fabric of the road can deteriorate more rapidly and cause further safety issues. We are also keen to ensure surfaces are not left in a condition that will negatively impact on emergency service vehicles.

Once all schemes have been completed, no new schemes will commence until at such time it is determined it is appropriate to do so taking government advice into account.
