## **Details of Operational Decision Taken** [with reasons]:

Currently the licensing service require Hackney Carriage and Private Hire drivers to produce medical certificates that prove that they meet the DVSA Group 2 Medical Fitness to drive.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic appointments for medical examinations are proving very difficult to get. Our alternative provider is also unable struggling to offer appointments.

The licensing service are requesting authorisation that temporarily for a period of 3 months until the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020 that all those existing licence holders that require a medical certificate are permitted to complete a self-declaration to inform the Licensing Authority that their medical circumstances have not changed.

This arrangement will allow the renewal application to continue to be able to processed during this period.
