#### STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

### TM2/20/471:- Brookwater Close, Tottington

Over recent years the Council has received a number of complaints relating to parking on Brookwater Close, Tottington.

Brookwater Close does benefit from junction protection for a distance of 15 metres from its junction with Bury Road. Double parking tends to occur following the restrictions. Concerns have been raised that, as a result of the parking, the road is reduced to a single lane of traffic, and has reportedly caused near misses for vehicles turning into Brookwater Close. In addition the parking has reportedly on occasion hindered refuse collection vehicles and access to the rear of properties on Bury Road.

The Council has on a number of occasions written to residents in the surrounding area in an effort to improve parking behaviour, but this has proved unsuccessful.

In view of the recurring concerns it is proposed to extend the double yellow lines on the southeast side of Brookwater Close, to remove double parking and aid access to properties.

This was discussed by the Traffic Management Unit at its meeting of 03 December 2019, the decision being to recommend the extension of No Waiting at Any time and No Loading Monday – Friday 7.30-9.30am 4.00-6.30pm restrictions on Brookwater Close, Tottington.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.
