ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(2)

Under the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury, being satisfied that members of the public should be restricted or prohibited from using a dangerous section of highway and being satisfied that it is expedient or necessary that the restriction or prohibition should come into force without delay, hereby gives notice of the following that will apply from Saturday 02 May 2020 until 22 May 2020:-

1) No vehicle shall be permitted to proceed along the following lengths of road;

Alma Street, Radcliffe – between Adelphi Street and Lowe Street Cemetery Road, Radcliffe – at its junction with Ainsworth Road

2) No vehicle shall be permitted to wait at any time along the following lengths of road;

Cemetery Road, Radcliffe – between Ainsworth Road and a point 94 metres east of Alma Street

The reason for the proposed order is in the interests of highway safety to facilitate the controlled re-opening of the household waste recycling centre. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.

The alternative route will be:-

- 1) via Ainsworth Road
- 2) n/a
