## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(1) THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH OF BURY (PUBLIC FOOTPATH 105, BURY AND NON-DEFINITVE FOOTPATH WEST OF WARTH BUSINESS PARK) TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury intend in not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to prohibit any pedestrians from proceeding along:-

Public Footpath 105, Bury - from the western end of Warth Road to the crossing over the River Irwell at the west side of St Gabriels Roman Catholic School.

Non-Definitive Footpath at Warth Road, Bury -from the western end of Warth Road to the north end of Warth Fold Road, by the railway bridge.

The reason for the proposed order is to facilitate flood defence works

For PRW 105, Bury an alternative route will be to the south of the existing route and for the Non–Definitive footpath an alternative route will be along the westerly side of the Metrolink Line.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 24/09/20 and shall remain in force for a period of up to 6 months.
