Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

The Council's fleet of refuse collection vehicles (RCVs) is aging and increasingly unreliable, with the majority being more than 8 years old now. The original lease on them has expired and so they are working beyond their original life expectancy. Vehicle Workshops find it increasingly difficult to ensure that the Waste Management service has a sufficient number of vehicles available every day in order to operate a full service.

As a result of the above, x6 26 tonne RCVs are being hired in currently in order to maintain the necessary level of service.

It is proposed to extend the hire agreement through till January 2021, when 12 new vehicles are due to be delivered, for all 6 vehicles.

At the same time it is also proposed that the vehicles are hired from an alternative company at a lower rate, resulting in a reduction of costs.

Although there is no budget for these hired vehicles this is an operational necessity following previous years of not approving the replacement of vehicles, they will be funded through the Transport budget which unfortunately will lead to an overspend at the end of the financial year.
