## **Details of Operational Decision Taken** [with reasons]:

Bury Council are currently working in partnership with Bury Athletics Club to refurbish and improve the athletics facility at Market Street, Bury, whereby the track and surrounding facility are close to the end of their current lifespan as highlighted through UKA's TrackMark assessment conducted in November 2019 to January 2020.

A total of £250k has been set aside by the Council Capital Programme 2020/2021 for Bury Athletics Track essential improvements. This has been allocated on the understanding that the club match funds external grants of £250k for all the improvements required.

Bury Athletics Club have continued to successfully fundraise and apply for external grants as detailed below;

Donation of 800 concrete bullnose edgings from Marshalls Mono in Ramsbottom to replace the edgings around the outer edge of the 650m cinder track which runs around the perimeter of the Site. The Retail price of these edgings is £8.11 each and hence the value of this donation works out at £6,488.

Notification of a grant of £500 from the Duchy of Lancaster Benevolent Fund which has been awarded to help fund the renovation of the 650m cinder track.

It would be beneficial to have the upgrade of the 650m cinder track completed prior to work commencing on the 400m synthetic track (anticipated March/April 2021) so that athletes (and other users) have a track to train on whilst work is being undertaken on the main facility.

Approval request to release £6,988 from the Operations Capital Programme 2020/21 to contribute the cinder track upgrade work.
