## **Summary:**

Approval for GMCA (acting by its officer, TfGM) to be authorised to award the contract for system/services for the Greater Manchester Clean Air Plan retrofit grant platform to Fluent Technology utilising the initial tranche of £36m of funding from Government to deliver the CAZ and other GM CAP measures.

The attached Delegation Report provides more information but brief details are provided below.



In a report to cabinet on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2020 it was advised that, given the scale and challenging timeline to deliver a charging Clean Air Zone as required by the Ministerial Direction, there is preparatory work that needs to be undertaken to maintain delivery momentum.

On 20<sup>th</sup> May 2020 Councillor Alan Quinn approved that the GMCA (acting by its officer, TfGM) is authorised to undertake the preparatory procurement arrangements that need to be undertaken to deliver the CAZ and other GM CAP measures on behalf of Bury Council in accordance with TfGM's existing Constitutional arrangements.

Part of the preparatory procurement arrangements is the appointment of a supplier of a digital grant management/administration platform to administer funding to eligible applicants for the Clean Air Grant Retrofit (Bus, Coach, Taxi and HGV) and Clean Bus Replacement Fund.

This is the fund that will be offered to GM businesses to help them to upgrade their vehicles to cleaner compliant models.

It is anticipated that the volume of applications for the Clean Air Grant Retrofit (Bus, Coach, Taxi and HGV) and Clean Bus Replacement Funding will be 960+bus retrofit applications, 520+bus replacement applications and 270 retrofit applications for other coaches, taxis and HGVs.

TfGM have now completed a robust procurement exercise to deliver this function and as a result:

Councillors Alan Quinn and Lucy Smith are recommended to approve that GMCA (acting by its officer, TfGM) is authorised to award to the contact to Fluent Technology utilising the initial tranche of £36m of funding from Government to deliver the CAZ and other GM CAP measures.
