

STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

TM2/20/479 — THROSTLE GROVE, BURY

Local residents have reported concerns regarding parking on Throstle Grove, Bury near to its junction with Brandlesholme Road.

Parking on Throstle Grove occurs is mainly evenings and weekends and impacts on vehicles turning into and out of its junction with Brandleholme Road.

In view of the concerns it is proposed to introduce some waiting restrictions on Throstle Grove to alleviate access and obstruction problems.

This report was circulated to the Traffic Management Unit members for 31 March 2020, the decision being to recommend the introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions to alleviate visibility, access and obstruction problems.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.

Proposed Introduction of No Waiting at any Time Restrictions SCHEDULE

Throstle Grove, Bury

South side from the westerly kerbline of Brandlesholme Road for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction

North side from the westerly kerbline of Brandlesholme Road for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction
