

Westminster Ave, Radcliffe – Coronation Rd to Honiton Gr

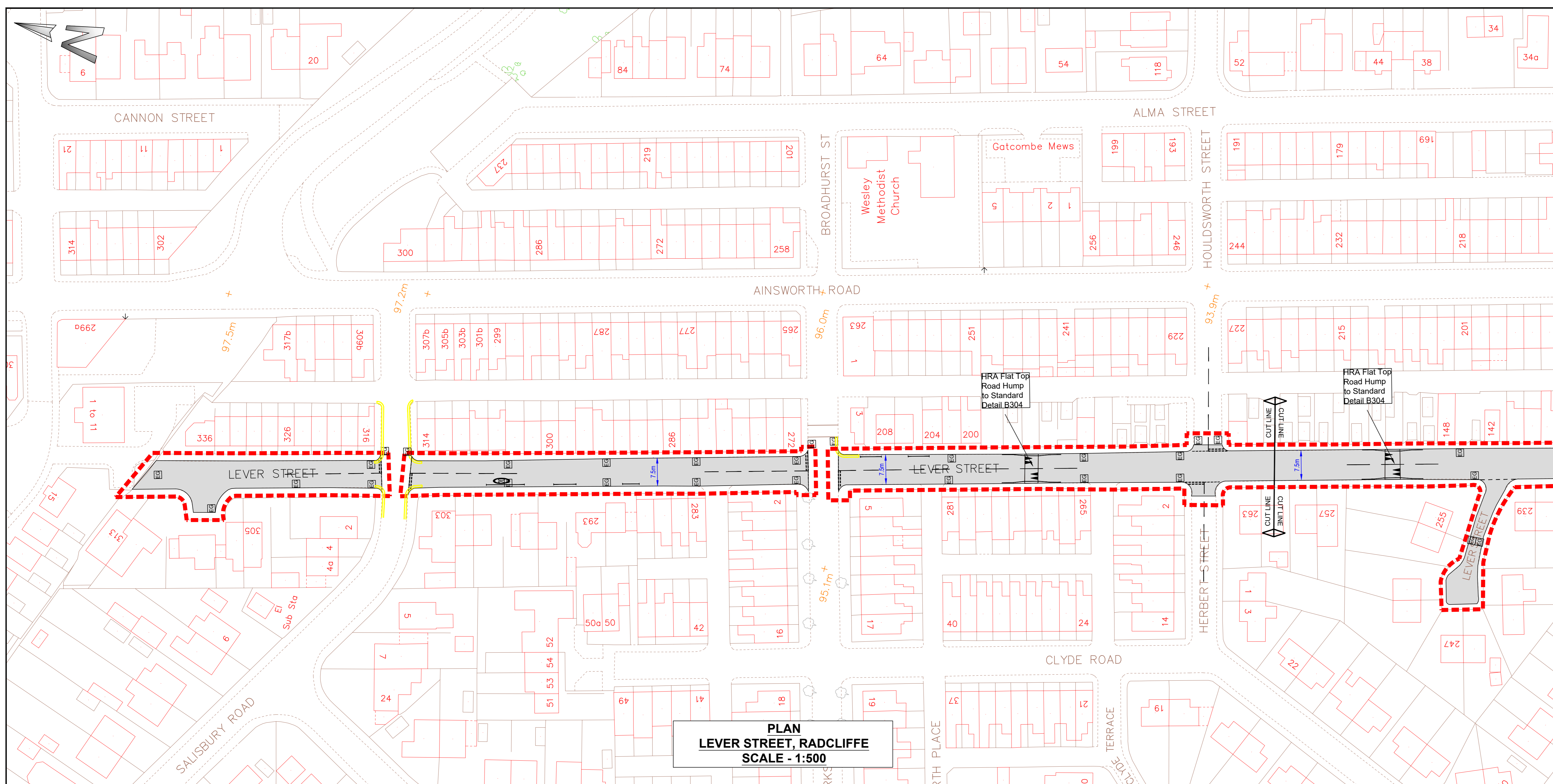
The reason for the proposed order is to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works

Local diversions will be signed on site where applicable

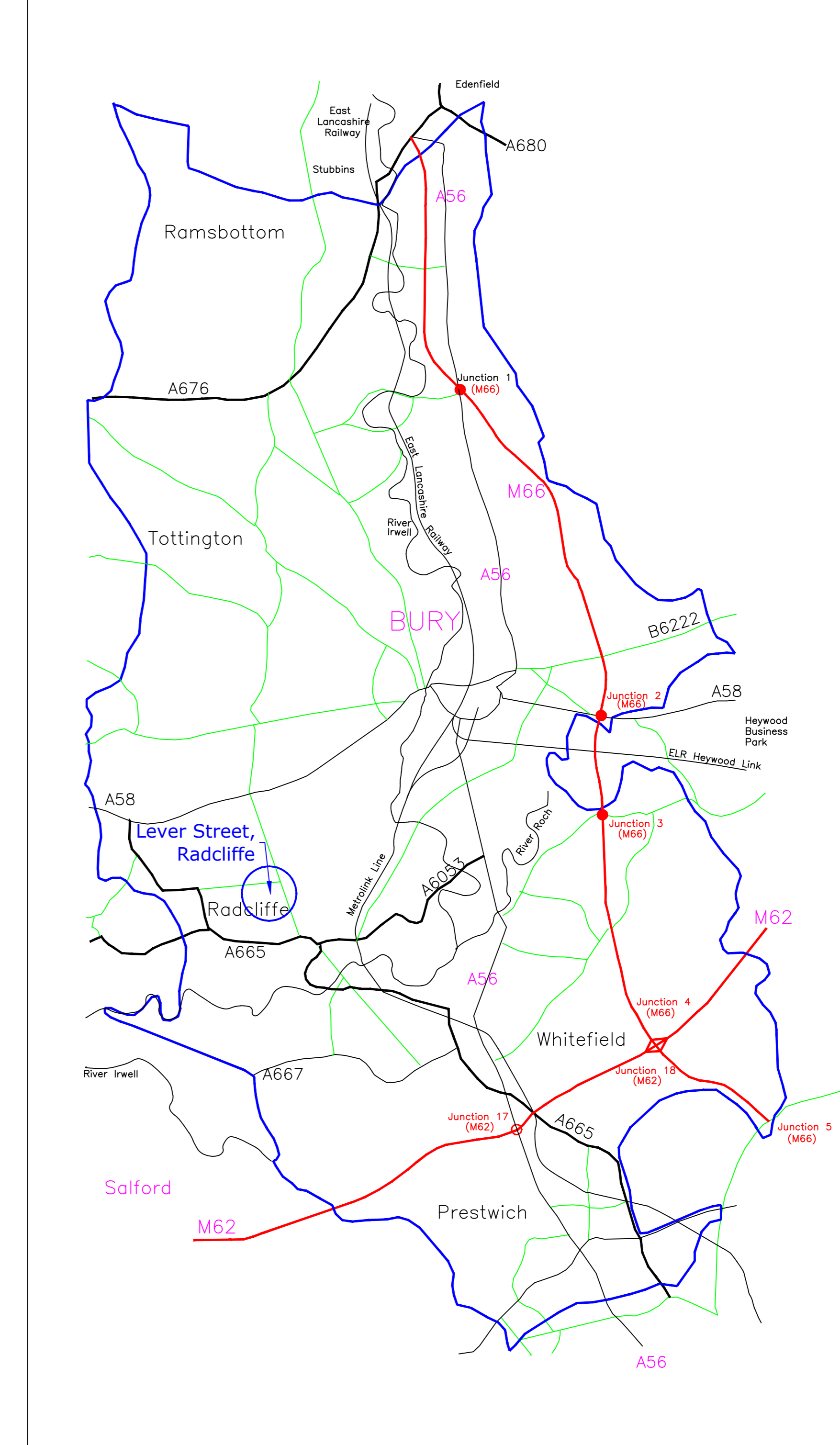
The proposed Order will come into operation on 11/01/21 and shall remain in force for a period of up to 6 months, although the anticipated duration of the works is approximately 2 months. Closures will only be implemented as and when required by the works.

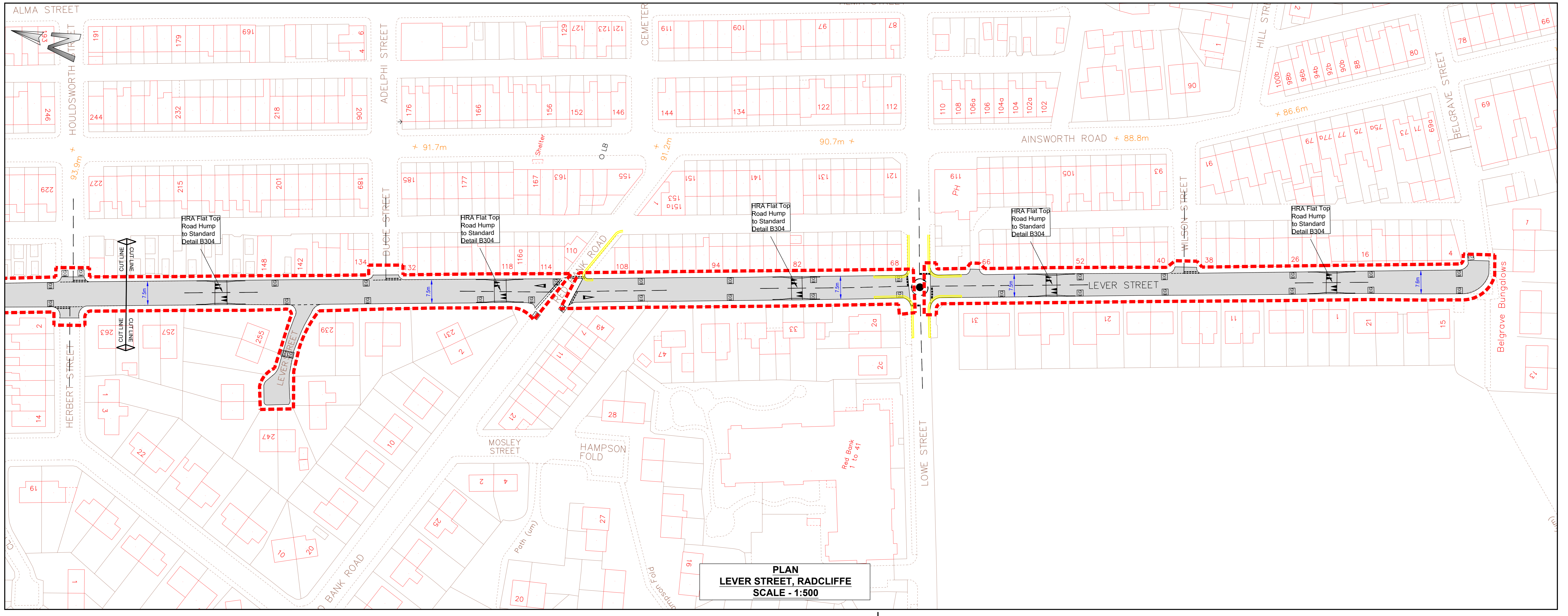
**PLAN

- Dimensions shall not be scaled from the drawing.
 - All dimensions are in millimetres unless otherwise stated.
 - All coordinates and levels are in metres unless otherwise stated.
 - All callouts are in metres unless otherwise stated.
- Setting Out & Survey Data**
- Before proceeding with any construction activities, all setting out is to be agreed with the Engineer or Engineer's Representative on site.
 - The Contractor is responsible for surveying and recording the layout and extents of the existing carriageway road markings to ensure their reinstatement is correct.
- General**
- All Carriageway, footway and drainage works to be undertaken as outlined in Appendix 1/13.
 - All works are to be constructed in accordance with the Specification for Highway Works published as Volume 1 of the Manual of Contract Documents for Highway Works and Bury Council's Standard Detail booklet.
 - Drop crossings must have an upstand of 6mm & 20mm in pedestrian and vehicular crossings respectively, unless directed by the Engineer.
 - Short lengths/areas of kerb, edging and flag replacement shall be as directed by the Engineer.
 - Extents of deep patching shall be as directed by the Engineer.
 - Bond coat shall be HAPAS approved / polymer modified bitumen emulsion and tanker applied.
 - The vertical joint between existing and new surfacing shall be painted with 100 pen bitumen.
 - All statutory undertakers covers and frames are to be reset to suit new carriageway levels.
 - On completion of surfacing the Contractor must clear all gullies and ensure they are serviceable.
 - The Contractor will be responsible for liaising with TFGM in relation to bagging off signals (See Appendix 1/13.12). All costs associated with the bagging off of signal heads shall be included in the Contractor's rates for Traffic Management.
 - The Contractor shall be responsible for liaising with TFGM in relation to closing bus stops and any cost associated must be included in the Contractor's rates for Traffic Management. Contact: stop.closures@tfgm.com

- 60mm HRA 60/20 bin PMB WTR 2 to Clause 943 Areas if not shown to be identified on site (Provisional)
- 20mm AC 6 dense surf 100/150 with varying depths of AC 20 dense bin 100/150
- Take up and relay 600x900mm Concrete Flags 63mm thick on 35mm sharp sand (if not shown to be identified on site)
- Existing gully
- Existing gully to be replaced with new P1 gully connected to existing 150mm connection
- 150x305 Bullnose PCC Kerb with 160mm upstand
- 125x255 Half Battered or 125x150mm Bullnose PCC Kerb in Drop Crossings
