Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

To agree to extend the current contract with Jones Lighting Limited until the 31st of December 2020.

The current AGMA Street Lighting Electrical Connections Framework has recently come to the end of its 4 year term, and is currently going through the process re-tendering. This is anticipated being in place as of the 1^{st} of January 2021.

Wigan are managing the tender process and have already agreed with Jones Lighting to extend the current contract and associated rates until 31 December 2020, and are asking if other participating Authorities wish to do the same.

It is estimated that Bury's spend for column replacement until the 31^{st} of December 2020 will be approximately £545,000 of which approximately £243,000 will be paid to Jones Lighting, the difference being for materials. This has been discussed with procurement who agree that an extension is the most practical approach, given the estimated expenditure, the time until the new contract is in place, and the need to maintain progress on the column replacement programme.

Funding for the column replacement programme was approved at cabinet on the 4th September 2019
