Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:

Winter service gritting for the 2020/21 season will be delivered through a 5 shift pattern rota, each shift consisting of 1 Supervisor/Driver and 3 Drivers. All of these positions require an appropriate HGV license.

The number of expressions of interest received in winter service driver positions exceeds the 15 positions available. An interview selection process will be carried out to appoint to the positions available.

Restrictions on driver hours can result in winter service drivers not being available to carry out their normal duties. The loss of waste collection drivers as a result of winter service gritting operations causes significant disruption to the waste collection service. The impact of the loss of HGV drivers on other services outside of waste collections is less disruptive.

In order to reduce this impact on waste collections a maximum of 5 winter service driver positions (1 per shift) will be allocated to existing Waste Management drivers.
