STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

TM2/20/485:- Back Brierley Street South, Bury

A request has been received from Serviam Planning, Town Planners who are acting for their clients at Heaton House, Brierley Street, Bury to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions at the side of (Back Brierley Street South) and in front of (Brierley Street) Heaton House to alleviate access and obstruction problems.

Heaton House is a recent conversion from a single property to flats with access to a rear car park through gates on Back Brierley Street South.

To alleviate access issues on the cobbled back street, the developer has already introduced yellow lines at this location, without an application to Bury Council for a traffic regulation order. However, Serviam Planning now wish to formalize the yellow lines and indeed extend them into Brierley Street in front of Heaton House.

This report was circulated to the Traffic Management Unit members for 29 September 2020, the decision being to recommend the introduction of No Waiting at Any time restrictions on Back Brierley Street South and Brierley Street, Bury to alleviate access and obstruction problems.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.

SCHEDULE

Introduction of No Waiting at Any time

Back Brierley St South, Bury – North side from the westerly kerblines of Brierley St to the westerly kerblines of Back Brierley St South

Brierley St, Bury – West side from the northerly kerblines of Back Brierley St South for a distance of 5m in a northerly direction
