#### Summary:

As part of the response to Covid-19, the Government have written to residents notifying them that they are advised to shield and will be prioritised for a Covid-19 vaccination.

It is intended to issue a follow-up letter informing Bury residents of the support that is available to them locally including:

- Clinically Extremely Vulnerable People
- Covid 19 Vaccinations
- Support available

The intention is to use our current supplier Critiqom. We have a contract with this company, and they have previously undertaken work for the Council including the council tax communications and a letter to the over 70s on advice during the pandemic.

The Council's Procurement Team has confirmed that that they are in agreement with this approach and the current contract can be used for this purpose.

The total cost for print and postage is £1,688.00.

The government has made available funding to local authorities to support shielding and the cost of this proposal will be met from this allocation. (Lisa Kitto 04.03.21)
