## **Details of Operational Decision Taken** [with reasons]:

In April 2020 The Council became a participant in the AGMA contract for the provision of an Employee Assistance Programme involving Counselling, Cognitive Behaviour Therapy (CBT), a 24/7/365 helpline and an online portal/mobile application to support the welfare of the employees.

The contract was awarded to People Asset Management Ltd and currently provides support to employees of The Council and Persona. In May 2020 a request from the Fostering Service to extend the service to Foster Carers was approved and they are now included in the provision.

An additional request has been received from Six Town Housing to participate in the contract from the  $1^{st}$  April 2021 as their current contract does not provide the level of service that the council's EAP contract covers.

Following consultation with the Council's Head of Strategic Procurement and members of her team we have been advised that the two additions represent a variation to the original contract requirement and as such in accordance with the Council's Contract Procedure Rule 15 require the operational approval through this form of the appropriate Chief Officer of the Council.

It is therefore recommended that approval be granted to add the following number of additional personnel from each service to the provision of the contract:

Six Town Housing -234 employees Fostering Service – 132 carers

It should also be noted that this variation will not result in any additional expense as any costs will be recharged to the relevant organisation/service.
