Details of Operational Decision Taken [with reasons]:					

Jigsaw are a charitable organisation who provide peer support, volunteer services and social activities for young disabled people as well as a project called Jigsaw Link which connects people over 55 years to prevent isolation where people are un-befriended.

Current contract value £29,000 per annum.

There are no other voluntary sector organisations delivering this type of customer led service which reaches both disabled young people and people over 55 years old in the community.

The current contract is delivered by 4 paid office staff and 54 active volunteers. The charity engages with other community groups and carries out fund raising activities to deliver the service in addition to the Council's funding contribution. Contract monitoring is carried out quarterly and annually.

The funding awarded to Jigsaw represents value for money to Bury Council as it costs Bury Council £2.08 per person per week to deliver services.

Decision required to continue funding Jigsaw for a further 12 months.
