The reason for the proposed order is to facilitate the holding of a street party.

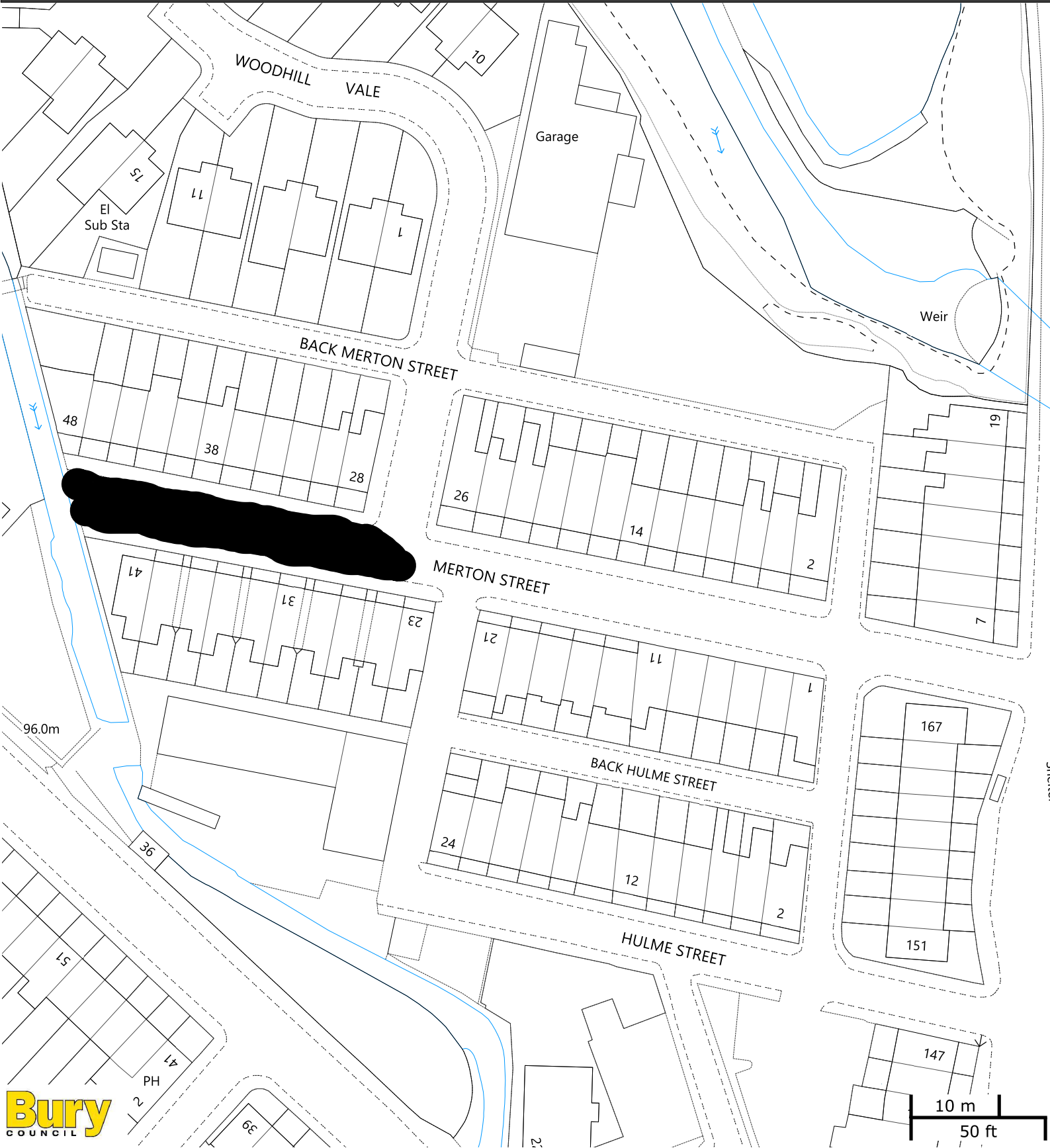
There is no practicable alternative route.
