

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(2)

Under the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury, being satisfied that members of the public should be restricted or prohibited from using a dangerous section of highway and being satisfied that it is expedient or necessary that the restriction or prohibition should come into force without delay, hereby gives notice that from 06/09/21 until safe to do so, no person shall be permitted to proceed along the following lengths of road;

Polefield Road, Prestwich - from its junction with Heywood Road for a distance of 40 metres in a southerly direction

The reason for the proposed order is facilitate footway reconstruction works

The alternative route will be via Heywood Rd, Bury Old Rd & St Margarets Rd & vice versa.
