

STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

TM2/21/509 – ALSTON STREET AND DAVID STREET, BURY

Concern has been expressed regarding parked vehicles causing access and obstruction problems for vehicles exiting and entering Elton Community Centre, Alston Street, Bury.

At school times, parking near to the Community Centre entrance can cause access difficulties particularly as Alston Street in front of the Community Centre is narrow and is also a problem due to the one-way system which means that vehicles can only access the Community Centre entrance from either David Street or nearby back streets. Observations on David Street and Alston Street have indicated that there are additional access/visibility problems caused by double parked vehicles on David Street near to its junction with Walshaw Road.

In addition, parking on the junction of David Street and Alston Street also restricts access to Alston Street.

This report was circulated to the Traffic Management Unit members for comments on Tuesday 28 September 2021, the decision being to recommend the introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions to alleviate the access and obstruction.

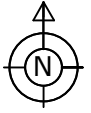
The extent of the proposed parking restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.

Schedule – Proposed No Waiting at Any time

Alston Street, Bury (in front of the Elton Community Centre car park and to the side of Elton Primary School) - Northerly side (opposite Elton Youth Centre) from the easterly kerbline of Alston Street for a distance of 13 metres in an easterly direction. Southerly side from a point 38 metres west of the westerly kerbline of David Street for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction. Southerly side from the westerly kerbline of David Street for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction

David Street, Bury – Both sides from the northerly kerbline of Walshaw Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction. Westerly side from the southerly kerbline of Alston Street for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.
