Locality Board Chair's Report

- 1.1 The Locality Board received at their meeting on 10th January 2022, a verbal update from Mr Little on the Key Issues in the Bury Health and Care System and also a position statement in regard to the GM ICS Transition.

- 1.3 For the purpose of this Chair's report, a number of key areas of discussion separate from the above have been expanded upon and detailed as below:

2 Healthwatch Update

- 2.1 The Locality Board welcomed a presentation from Ms Passman, the Chair of Bury Healthwatch. The presentation covered a variety of topics such as; the Year of Change, New Ways of Engagement, making reports and information more accessible, refreshing their website as well as providing some key statistics on the number of; engagement sessions held, complaints and compliments received and sign-postings to other services. All this information was received and noted.
- 2.2 Healthwatch remains as a standing item on the Locality Board agendas for each meeting. At the next Locality Board meeting (7th February 2022), will be a Patient Lived Experience talk in which the Locality Board receive in order to understand those barriers being experienced and as well as areas of good practice.

3. Integrated Neighbourhood Teams update/presentation

- 3.1 Members of the Integrated Neighbourhood Teams were present at the meeting and as such carried out a detailed presentation which provided an overview on the following;

4. Bury Health and Care Outcomes and Performance Report

- 4.2 The report submitted gave an overview of performance metrics and indicators.
