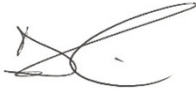

TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Metropolitan Borough of Bury intend in not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicles from proceeding along:-

Dumers Ln, Radcliffe – between Manchester Rd & Wellfield Cl

The reason for the proposed order is to facilitate water mains replacement works

The alternative route will be Northbound: Manchester Rd, Radcliffe Rd, Bury Rd, Cross Ln & Bury St AND Southbound: Manchester Rd, Radcliffe New Rd, New Rd, Pilkington Way, Spring Ln, Cross Ln & Bury St

The proposed Order will come into operation on 02/04/22 and shall remain in force for a period of up to 6 months, although the anticipated duration of the works is approximately 2 weeks.
